**2022 -** THP raised \$15,000 dollars for in water research on the island of Carriacou, Grenada, W.I. This led to the collaboration with Ocean Spirits, the local turtle conservation project, and UVI Sea Turtle Research and Conservation (UVISTRC) to reach our goal of assessing the in water population of hawksbill and green turtles on the island of Carriacou.

**2023 -** We more than doubled our fundraiing efforts and returned with Ocean Spirits, to Carriacou to build on the knowledge gained in 2022. Additionally, THP also collaborated with UVISTRC to conduct the first in water assessment of sea turtles around the island of St. John, USVI. Both projects filled a major data gap for spatial distribution of hawksbill turtles in the Caribbean.

**2024 -** Our fundraising level tripled, and THP returned to <u>St. John, US Virgin Islands for the second year of the study</u>.
